

Home Educators of Yuma - Student Code of Conduct

"Do all things without complaining or arguments; so that you will prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world" - Philippians 2:14-15 NASB20

In order to provide a safe and wholesome environment for our children, the following rules and guidelines have been established:

1. Be on time for PAC class or other events.
2. Dress appropriately for the event.
3. Treat all people with respect: PAC coaches, adults, fellow students. (I Peter 2:13-17; Romans 13:1) If conflicts or concerns arise between students, we encourage respectful Christ-like problem solving. However, ongoing issues, situations that feel uncomfortable, or behavior that is inappropriate should be brought to the attention of a board member, PAC coach, or teen coordinator as soon as possible.
4. Wherever HEY events are held, whether a public place such as a park, a private residence or a place of business, please treat these places and the people in them with respect.
5. Have an attitude of compassion for the differences, needs, or disabilities of others. (James 2:1-9; Galatians 5:22-23)
6. Act and speak in a manner worthy of the God who calls you - unkind remarks, profanity, coarse jokes, conversation involving occult or sexual situations or other language unbecoming to a Christian is unacceptable at HEY functions. (I Thessalonians 2:12; Ephesians 4:1, 5:4)
7. The use of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products, vaping, illegal drugs or the possession or use of weapons (not including pocket knives or multi-purpose tools, i.e. Gerbers) is not permitted during any HEY functions. (Noncompliance with this item will result in expulsion from the current activity, and for the second offense, expulsion from all HEY activities.) (Matthew 5:16; Galatians 5:19-21)
8. Wholesome friendships are encouraged between boys and girls. However, students should look upon one another as brothers and sisters in Christ and refrain from demonstrating personal affection at all HEY functions. (Galatians 5:24; Romans 12:10; Ephesians 5:3)
9. Be kind to and watchful of younger children.
10. If you are at PAC or other HEY activity but are not actively participating (for example before your class begins) you are still required to adhere to this Code of Conduct.
11. DO UNTO OTHERS AS YOU WOULD HAVE THEM DO UNTO YOU. (Matthew 7:12)
